

GLOBALLY, WE SUPPORT AND PROTECT 63,000 CHILDREN IN 31 COUNTRIES






At least 3 out of every 4 of the world's children

experience some form of inter-personal violence, cruelty or abuse in their daily lives, regardless of whether they live in rich countries or poor, in the global North or the global South.





Sexual violence against girls was most prevalent in Africa where more than one in every ten adolescent girls aged 15–19 had experienced some form of sexual violence in their lifetimes.



MALI - CHILD PROTECTION CHANNELS OF HOPE

BACKGROUND: The project organized

3 training sessions

for 200 faith (170 male – 30 female) and community leaders

2 training sessions

for 400 orphan guardians (250 male – 150 female), 30 volunteers (10 male – 20 female), 15 suppliers (10 male – 5 female)

3 trainings sessions

for 200 children (100 boys -100 girls).

At the beginning and at the end of these trainings, pretraining tests and post- training tests were administered.

OUTCOMES:

The results shows that initially only 5% of attendants had knowledge on what Gender Based Violence, child rights, child abuse, violence, positive discipline and early marriage were, the post- tests indicated that 100% of attendants now knew.

Approximately 75 cases of abuse were being reported across all 17 schools to the School Management Committees or Village chiefs each month, the end line has shown that only 15 cases of abuse are now reported on a monthly basis.

Channels of Hope Action Team members and Child Protection Clubs have held 15 awareness campaigns, contributing as agents of social change in securing administrative documents for 200 children alongside authorities and stopping 45 parents from proceeding with Early and Forced Marriage of their girls.

YEMEN

7500 children received support in psychosocial support, hygiene, health and Disaster Risk Reduction in a total of 720 sessions conducted.

16 schools have been rehabilitated up to the safety standards of safety and pedagogic norms providing child friendly spaces for children affected by war.

LEBANON

Our psycho-social support projects have reached more than **1,000 children**.

7 faith leaders (Male) in wajir county were trained on child rights and protection and their role as faith leaders to educate the community and champion for children's rights and protection.
