## CONSTRUCTING MATERNITY CENTRE

Maternity centres are lifesavers for mothers to be and new-born babies. Building a maternity centre with vital equipment, ambulances and medically trained staff changes the risks mothers and babies face, and ultimately saves lives.




### MOBILE CLINICS
